Special Education Study Session

Superintendent Waldfogel reviewed the topics to be discussed including revenue and expense trends, budget increases and impacts, and proposed action plans to address budget and program goals. Deputy Superintendent Vern Medeiros provided an in-depth look at the special education budget, documenting an ongoing encroachment to the General Fund and stagnant funding by both the State and federal governments. Nancy Melgares reviewed program challenges including substantial increases in identified students and mandated service costs, inaccurate data collection and reporting, and intensified legal challenges. Recommended action plans were presented by Assistant Superintendent Leah Laule including increasing program staff to monitor expenditures, professional audit of contracts and services, review of the Individual Education Plan (IEP) process, improved data collection via upgraded software, and increased legislative action.

Member Wallin reported that the California Association of Suburban School Districts (CALSSD) organization has expressed interest in writing a bill in support of full funding for special education funding.
