- x Coordinate and facilitate professional development of the ECLC Special to program.
- x Provide administrative oversight of the ECLC Special Education program.
- x Coordinate and collaborate with the Director of Special Educ**Æier**mentary on all aspects of preschool instruction.
- x Facilitate and model effective collaborativent munication to support professional learning communities
- x Attend district meetings as needed
- x Serve as a preschool, TK/K liaison to our schools and parent community
