

## COORDINATOR IV: ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

### DEFINITION:

Under the general direction of the Director of Literacy, provide support implementation of CA Standards and Frameworks for all grade levels, oversee professional learning, and assist in development, implementation and evaluation of curriculum and instruction in English Language Arts (ELA) TK-12.

### ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Demonstrate an understanding of and support implementation of CA Standards and Frameworks for all grade levels
  - Assist in the development, implementation, and evaluation of curriculum and the instruction in ELA
  - Assist in the collection, interpretation, and use of data and assessment results to improve instructional practice and student learning
  - Coordinate ELA instruction across all school sites
  - Coordinate ELA instructional materials adoption
  - Coordinate ELA professional learning and support materials in collaboration with the Director of Literacy and the Director of Professional Learning
  - Facilitate and model effective collaborative communication to support professional learning communities
  - Evaluate and supervise department Teachers on Special Assignment (TOSAs)
  - Coordinate Primary Literacy Project
  - Attend district meetings as needed
  - Serve as an ELA liaison to our schools and parent community
  - Support coordination of content related events (i.e. Read Across America Day)
