- x In looking at the Updated Unrestricted real Fund and Components of the Ending Fund Balance, Mr. Fogarty noted the 2011/12 Quarter of \$2,904,263 which stemmed from savings from the implemented Spending Freeze broughtby the Governor's Proposition 30; of which staff needs to decide how to reallocate these funds.
- x In conclusion, Mr. Fogarty mentioned somethous items the Districtvill be watching and implementing in the future:
  - ➤ Growth: The Irvine Company is buildin 19,000 new homes. Integer Fields is working on getting approvals to build up to 9,500 new homes.
    - IUSD will be opening Cypress Village Elemmatary school and an interim Portola Spring Elementary school, at the former street of Basics site, in the fall of 2014. With the Portola Springs school to be mplete by the fall of 2015. Looking beyond, we are scheduled to open a K+8osc and the fifth high school in the Heritage Fields area in 2016.
  - Affordable Care Act: Staff have been longilinto the impact of the Affordable Care Act on the District, including poteinal cost and the need to provide healthcare for any part-time employee who happens to work 30 moore hours a week in a given year.
