#### Minutes:

Member Glasky added a tenth item to the numbered items in Resolution No. 17-18-36 as follows: "10. The boundaries of the trustee areas shall consider topography and geography, such as man-made geographical features including freeways, highways and major streets, etc. as potential divisions between trustee areas, insofar as practicable".

Members Wallin and Glasky amended the resolution section starting with BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED... to add, "in no particular order" to the end of the section.

Member Wallin amended the resolution title to remove the word Boundary, changing the title to "Resolution Establishing Criteria for Consideration of Developing Trustee Areas".

Board Members expressed the importance of including the criteria in developing possible trustee areas for each high school's attendance area to have more than one Board Member representative.

Community member, Bruce Williams-Smith, attended the meeting with a question concerning the trustee area process. To facilitate his question, the School Board asked
