



Under general supervision, provides direct consultation and instruction in the fields of adapted physical education to students in grades kindergarten through twelve. Assists schools in meeting individual pupil needs in the areas of motor skills, physical fitness, self-image, social behavior, and recreational interests.

- Consults with regular and special education teachers regarding adapting or modifying the physical education program for handicapped students. Conducts workshops to assist staff in understanding when Specifically Designed Physical Education is appropriate and when "Adapted Physical Education" is appropriate.
