- Direct the provision of services for disabled students in a large school district effectively direct due process activity to the benefit of the district.
- Collaborate with site principals to ensure appropriate educational modifications for disabled students.

Background which demonstrates at least three years of extensive and progressively responsible school and
central office administrative experience with extensive responsibility within Special Education at least three
years of successful teaching experience, with the majority of time in Special Education advanced knowledge
of legal requirements in the provision of services for disabled students, and in the area of due process activity
mediations, hearings, and settlements.
