



## TEACHER EDUCATION SPECIALIST

### DEFINITION:

Under general supervision, serves as a member of the Individual Education Program Planning Team and participates in decisions regarding placement of students with exceptional needs.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following: Other duties may be assigned.

- x Appraises academic, behavioral, and perceptual functioning of an individual student.
- x Implements and monitors students' Individual Education Plans.
- x Provides a basic core curriculum program for special education students consistent with state and federal education code requirements.
- x Recommends to support staff, classroom teacher, parents and district personnel appropriate diagnostic/instructional services for individuals with exceptional needs.
- x Provides consultative, resource, and supervisory services in program and curriculum planning, research, and program evaluation for special projects involving students with exceptional needs within the school and at the district level special education students in general education classes, interpreting the needs of the entire staff, and assisting the student's referral of an individual with exceptional needs when their needs cannot be met by the services provided.
- x Consults with parents (or guardians) and members of related disciplines, including outside agencies regarding the needs of an individual with exceptional needs.
- x Confers frequently with parents and professional staff members regarding the educational, behavioral, and social needs of students with exceptional needs.
