# **DEFINITION:**

Under the supervision of the assigned supervisor, leads and performs skilled and semi-skilled journeyman level painting and paint-related maintenance tasks in support of the District's facilities maintenance program. mixes and applies paints or other surface coatings to buildings, equipment and furniture; develops

scaffolding and platforms.

When not engaged in the above activities, may assist as required in a variety of maintenance work throughout the district involving heavy manual labor and semi -skilled and skilled tasks.

Drives a vehicle to conduct work.

Maintain's various records related to paints, work orders and assigned activities; updates Maintenance Plan.

Maintain s shop and work areas in a safe, clean and orderly condition.
