Maintain and establish cooperative working relationships.
Understand, carryout and give oral and written instructions.
Keep work records and make reports.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

Equivalent to the completion of the twelfth grade or GED with supplemental vocational courses dealing with automotive and mechanical courses. Four years of responsible journeyman level experience in heavy-duty mechanical repair work.

LICENSES AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Possess and maintain a valid California motor vehicle operator's license.
A valid California Class B Driver's License with passenger endorsement is preferred.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Bending at the waist, climb, balance, kneeling or crouching.
Reaching overhead, above the shoulders and horizontally.
Dexterity of hands and fingers to operate power tools and equipment.
Regularly lift and/or move up to 50 pounds; lifting, carrying, pushing or pulling heavy objects up 100 pounds with assistance.
Seeing to observe and perform repairs.
Hearing and speaking to exchange information.
Stand, sit for periods of time

WORK ENVIRONMENT:

Indoor/Outdoor environment. The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate. Hazards include:

Seasonal heat and cold or adverse weather conditions.
Contact with electrical outlets
Working around hazardous materials
Working around or with machinery having moving mechanical parts
