

Under the supervision of the Special Education Coordinator, provides educationally related behavioral/mental health services including individual and group counseling, consultations, assessments, referrals, and mental health educational programs for students identified with mental health disorders or related special education needs referred for service through their IEP team; conducts ERMHS assessments to determine student placement; serves as a part of a multi-disciplinary team; plans and conducts mental health related professional development training for District personnel; supplements

plans and conducts ongoing specialized mental health trainings and provides mental health related assistance to District staff.

Operates a variety of office equipment including a copier, a computer and assigned software; drives a vehicle to conduct work.
